



Cedar Community will not permit family gatherings with residents in the outdoor spaces on the private property of the Cedar Lake, Cedar Run, Cedar Ridge, or Elkhart Lake campuses. This will continue as long as Cedar Community remains under the lockdown orders of the Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department, regardless of “social distancing” guidelines. Cedar Community staff will ask any families that encourage residents to visit with them outdoors to leave the campus property.

We appreciate that it is extremely difficult to be under the lockdown restrictions during this time. Please know that the State of Wisconsin Department of Health and the Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department intend to continue the lockdown orders for all long-term care facilities, even past the expiration of the general public “Safer at Home” orders.
