COVID-19 Update - Baseline Testing for Cedar Lake Health and Rehabilitation Center

As we shared with you yesterday, the Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department lifted the lockdown order for long-term care facilities. As we begin working on our phased re-opening plans, we will be conducting baseline COVID-19 testing for residents and team members who work in the Cedar Lake Health and Rehabilitation Center. This also includes any partner vendor team members from BSG, Concept Rehab, and Parasol Alliance who work in the building.

The testing is an important part of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) guidelines for re-opening the healthcare center to visitors. This testing does not apply to any of the assisted living or independent living locations at this time, including Cedar Bay East.

Testing will take place on Monday, June 22nd, and Tuesday, June 23rd.

Here are the details:

- Testing will be available between **6 a.m. and 4 p.m.** on both days
- Testing will take place in the back employee parking lot of the healthcare center
- You must be in your vehicle, and we ask that you stay in your vehicle for the test (no walk-ups)
- Enter the lower parking lot and follow the directional signs
- The test will be a nasal swab that will be self-administered, with nursing team member guidance
- The testing is not mandatory for team members, but it is strongly encouraged
- If you do not want to be tested, you must sign a declination form
- If you have been previously tested for COVID-19 we encourage you still take the test next week
- If you are tested at a different location (outside of Cedar Community) on Monday or Tuesday we will need a copy of the results
- Test results should be back to Cedar Community within 48 hours. If your test comes back positive, you will be notified and next steps will be communicated at that time
- All Cedar Lake Health and Rehabilitation Center residents will also be tested on these days
